The string program, held at Smithfield State High School, hosted 160 from approximately 17 schools. Students took part in an intensive two-day music workshop, working together to learn an entirely new set of ensemble pieces. Their hard work culminated in a concert performance on Friday afternoon, showcasing the incredible progress they've made in such a short time.

The Regional Ensemble experience was a wonderful opportunity for young musicians to extend themselves both musically and personally. Students had the chance to:

- Develop ensemble and performance skills in very large group settings.
- Collaborate with peers from other schools and form new friendships.

# The 'Scobettes" are off to State conference in Brisbane at the end of the month. Good luck Harmony and Willow!


